Blueberry Lemon Trifle

Too hot to turn on the oven? No Problem! These easy summer desserts are ready in a flash and don't even need to be baked. So keep cool and reward yourself with these no-bake recipes

Ingredients

3 Cups fresh blueberries 2 cans (15– 3/4 ounce each) lemon pie filling 2 cups lemon yogurt 1 prepared angel food cake (8 to 10 Ounces) cut into 1 in cubes 1 carton (8 ounces) frozen whipped topping, thawed

Optional: Lemon slices and fresh mint to top.



Directions

- 1. Set aside 1/4 cup blueberries for garnish. In a large bowl, combine pie filling and yogurt.
- In a 3-1/2-qt. serving or trifle bowl, layer a third of the cake cubes, lemon mixture and blueberries. Repeat layers twice. Top with whipped topping. Cover and refrigerate for at least 2 hours. Garnish with reserved blueberries and, if desired, lemon and mint.
