Supplies

- 1 Patterned Crew Sock
- 1 Solid Color Sock
- 1 piece Faux Fur (4×4 inches)
- 1 Wood Bead (1.25 inches)
- 1 Foam Cone (9 inches tall)
- Hot Glue Gun

Valentines Gnome Instructions

1. Cut off the bottom part of the solid color sock just under the heel and pull it up over the bottom of the cone.




2. Cut the beard from the fur and glue onto the solid sock.



3. Glue on the nose.

4. Use the patterned crew sock to make the hat. Cut it at an angle as shown and sew or glue.



5. Turn the hat right side out and place it over the top of the gnome. Embellish as desired.
